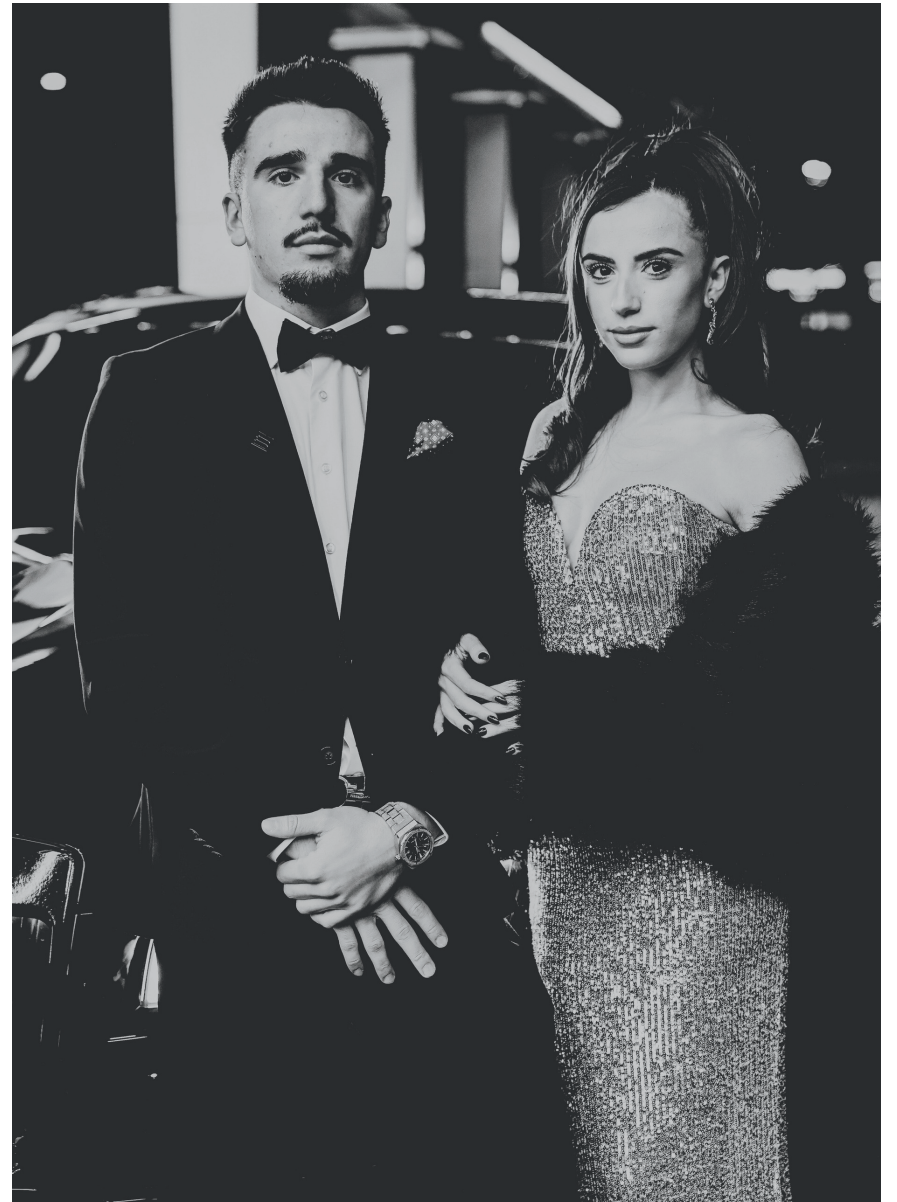
A NIGHT OF CELEBRATION AND GIVING
